NV Prosecco Vispo Allegro Vino Spumante, Italy 4.95 26.00
A sparkling wine with creamy and persistent bubbles and abundant fruity hints of acacia, honey, citrus fruits and almonds, characteristic of the grape variety of origin.

Langlois Chateau Cremant de Loire Brut, Loire, France 36.00
Vibrant and racy fruit, bready yeast flavours and zesty apple freshness is accompanied by the waxed lemon flavours of Chenin Blanc

Sparkling Rose

NV Ancre Hill Estate, Wales 59.00
Very pale salmon pink notes of straw. A soft nose of citrus, strawberries and bready summer fruits pudding. Lovely ripe citrus fruit, wild strawberries & cream on the palate with hints of vanilla. Soft persistent mousse with a soft and clean finish and delicate acidity.

Champagne

NV Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label, Reims 12.50 65.00
Lingering fruity flavours of apple and pear on the palate create a fresh, harmonious and lively Champagne.

Veuve Clicquot, White Label, Demi Sec 75.00
A beautiful yellow colour with deep golden glints and fine even mousse. An intense fragrance reminiscent of ripe fruit (candied citrus fruit, fruit liqueurs) with notes of brioche and toast, round and mellow in the mouth.

Laurent Perrier Grand Siecle, Grand Cuvee 195.00
Blend of a number of vintages and is a beautifully elegant, fresh, creamy style. Gloriously fine bubbles and a slight nuttiness complete a sophisticated experience all-round.

Lingering fruity flavours of apple and pear on the palate create a fresh, harmonious and lively Champagne.

Rose Champagne

Laurent – Perier, Tours-sur- Marne **95.00**

A classic pink Champagne, with plenty of stylish strawberry fruit and full of vivacity and drinking charm.

Veuve Clicquot, Vintage Rose 2008 **115.00**

This Champagne has a dense, brilliant, deep-coloured, a delicate pink with orange tints. The nose reveals intense aromas of red and black fruits (especially griotte cherries), enhanced with a touch of spices (pepper and vanilla).

NV Cosecha de Mayo, Semillon Tardio. Argentina 12% **4.50** **26.00**

Deep amber colour, concentrated toffee and raisins with a hint of candied orange peel, almost overpowering in its sweetness.

2014 Ginestet Sauternes, French 13% **4.50** **26.00**

Made exclusively from Sémillon this is a rich, delicious wine to linger over. An alluring seduction of heavenly honeyed lemons and limes with a ripe luscious richness.

2016 Pinot Griogio, Allamanda, Italy **4.25** **5.25** **22.00**

Cool-fermented and bottled early to capture all of the fresh summer-fruit flavours. Shows notes of raspberry and cherry on a refreshing palate.

2016 Twin Island Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand 12.5% 3.80 4.75 19.00

This Marlborough wine is pale straw in colour. Its lively fragrance combines passionfruit, citrus characters and fresh herbs. The palate is crisp and intense showing citrus flavours with hints of fresh coriander which lead to a mouth-watering and zesty finish.

2017 Chenin Blanc Viognier, Percheron, South Africa 13% 5.00 6.25 25.00

Richly aromatic on the nose with vibrant white stone fruit flavours and a pure, balanced finish

2015 Gavi, la Battistina, Italy 13% 5.40 6.75 27.00

This wine, produced only from estates grown grapes, has fresh citrus and pineapple aromas with ripe fruit balanced by crisp acidity on the palate

2015 Macon-Village La Colchette, Jean Loron, France 13% 6.40 8.00 32.00

Elegant floral and citrus nose with an underlying stone fruit character. Juicy citrus, white peach and cream surge through on the refined palate and linger well over a long, spicy finish. Superb.

Red Wine

2017 Baner Coeden Flag Tree Malbec, Argentina 12.5% 4.15 5.20 21.00

Aromas of fruits with hints of violets mingle with flavours of ripened plum and cherries accompanying this wine characteristically smooth and sweet tannis. This unique and delightful Malbec is well-balanced across the palate with a long and persistent finish.

2014 Running with Bulls Tempranillo, South Australia 13.5% 5.40 6.75 27.00

Medium cherry red in colour, blueberries, black cherries and fennel seed leap from the glass, with hints of ground coriander and chocolate. A juicy and plush palate, full of dark berries with mocha, choc tannins and a rustic ironstone finish.

2010 Yalumba Shiraz Viognier, South Australia 14% 5.80 7.20 29.00

Medium to deep red in colour the Yalumba Eden Valley Shiraz Viognier shows sweet, fresh and fragrant aromatics of red cherries and plums with a spice and clove complexity the complements the subtle perfumed floral hints of Viognier. On the palate, wine is rich and softly textured with characters of red fruits, fine spices and cloves, complemented by subtle sweet presence of Viognier.

2015 Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore, Italy 13.5% 6.40 8.00 32.00

Using the Ripasso technique, we obtain the maximum expression of the Corvina, Rondinella, Corvinone and Negrara grapes. Ruby-red, this wine offers intense aromas of wild cherries, redcurrant and hints of toasting. A rich and full-bodied wine, with sweet and round tannis.

White Wine

- 2016 Pinot Grigio, Allamanda, Italy 12%** **22.00**
With a crisp, dry, lightly floral character and a subtle honeyed note on the finish. This is a good example of Pinot Grigio, a white that has quickly become one of the most popular wines in Britain.
- NV La Mona, Moscatel Verdejo Semidulce, Spain 12%** **21.00**
Expect bright and fresh acidity with prevailing lemon, green apple, kiwi and pear. You will also enjoy fennel, musroom and a hint of grass. The wine is dry with hint of sweetness.
- 2014 Mas des Tannes, Chardonnay, France 13%** **27.00**
Rich and smooth on the palate, this wine is full of aromas of white flowers, fresh pear and passion fruit.
- 2016 Domaine des Tourelles, Vallee de La Bekka, Liban 13%** **28.00**
Blend of Chardonnay, Muscat of Alexandria, Viognier. Impressive, aromatic Lebanese white crying out for tasty Mediterranean food.
- 2016 Alsace, Gewurztraminer, Cave de Turckheim, France 13%** **28.00**
Lovely balance of ripeness, varietal purity and finesse (i.e. not overblown and flabby like some). Fragrant rose-petal/water and grapefruit aromas.
- 2015 Fritz Willi, Riesling, Germany 11.5%** **28.00**
Fragrant aromas of ripe apricots and red apples. Delicious citrus characters are balanced by refreshing minerality.
- 2014 Valdivieso Single Valley Lot Sauvignon Blanc, Chile 12%** **28.00**
Intense aroma of passion fruit and grapefruit. Tangy and mouth-watering with a touch of green tropical fruit flavours
- 2015 Cotes Du Rhone, La Fleur Solitaire, Boutinot, France 13%** **29.00**
A blend of Clairette, Grenache, Viognier and Roussanne. Brilliant, yellow with hint of green. Fine and intense floral aromas, notes of fresh and candied lemon. Nicely rounded and fresh, surprises with its complexity, freshness and lively structure.
- 2012 Cote Du Roussillon, Bila – Haut, M. Chapoutier, France 13%** **29.00**
Elegant citrus aromas and smoky notes. Great freshness is brought by a blend of Grenache Blanc, Grenache Gris and Macabeu.
- 2015 Whiteheaven, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 13%** **29.00**
Aromas of white peach, melon and mango with zesty sweet pea and citrus edge. The silken texture flows through a rich mid palate and clean finish. Predominantly ripe tropical fruit flavours with subtle mineral and savoury influence.
- 2016 Albarino Bodega Garzon, Uruguay 12.5%** **31.00**
This Albarino portrays ripe aromas of white peaches, citrus fruit like grapefruit and tangerine, ripe apricot and also light floral not of jasmine. It has a fresh, crisp and fruity mouth feel with mineral notes and is rounded off with extremely fresh and balanced acidity with good structure and delicious mouth-watering finish

- 2015 Gnarly Head Viognier, Manteca, California, 13.5%** **31.00**
Crisp and fruity with aromas and flavours of fresh peaches, apricots and orange blossom with a hint of violet
- 2015 The Olive Grove Chardonnay, Adelaide Hills, Australia 12.9%** **32.00**
It has a fresh nectarine and ripe lemon fruit bouquet and a twist of anise and fennel complements the uncluttered, fresh and juicy finish
- 2013 Rock Ferry, Pinot Blanc, New Zealand, 13%** **32.00**
Musky aromas with hints of orange blossom on the nose. The palate is richly textured and weighty with good focus and length. With age the wine will develop a lovely toasted almond, rich baked caramel and apple tart character.
- 2016 Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, France 12.5%** **36.00**
Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish.
- 2015 Chablis Domaine de la Motte, France 12.5%** **36.00**
Pale gold in colour with slight green tinges and a fruity nose with butter and hazelnut aromas.
- 2015 Cloudy Bay Chardonnay, New Zealand 14%** **38.00**
The palate is rich yet refined with a chalky texture supporting the delicious mineral-like complexity and creaminess derived from traditional winemaking techniques.
- 2014 Vire – Clesse, Chanson, France 13%** **39.00**
Pale gold colour. Very refreshing aromas of citrus fruit (grapefruit) mixed with fresh honey enhanced by a hint of minerality. Well – structured and tense. Well – integrated acidity and beautiful minerality. Energetic aftertaste.
- 2013 Torres, Fransola, Sauvignon Blanc, Penedes, Spain 13%** **55.00**
Rich, tropical fruit of passion fruit and fig is backed up by creamy but subtle oak. The palate is elegant and well poised. This is a great wine from this excellent single estate.
- 2014 Domaine Chante Cigale, Chateauneuf-Du-Pape, France 13.5%** **58.00**
25% Grenache Blanc, 25% Clairette, 25% Roussanne, 25% Bourboulenc. A full-bodied white with rich, ripe pear fruit that develops into floral and herby peachiness. The wine has a long leesy character and fresh acidity.
- 2013 Chateau Lamothe – Bouscaut, Pessac – Leognan, France 12.5%** **77.00**
A white wine blend of 70% Semillon and 30% Sauvignon Blanc. The wine shows a good balance between richness from the oak and mineral notes from the ‘terroir’ aromas of pear, melon and blossom.

Red Wine

2016 San Vigilio, Delle Venezie Merlot, Italy 12% **22.00**

This is a dry light and fruity wine to be drunk young. It is cherry red look at and there are floral and fruity notes on the nose. On the palate the texture is smooth with advanced tannins.

2015 San Perito, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile 13% **22.00**

Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouth feel.

2014 False Bay, Pinotage, South Africa 13.5% **24.00**

Dense, powerful mulberry and blackberry fruit, rich chocolate and plums with a fine tannin structure and delicious sweet, ripe fruit finish.

2015 Chateau de Fleurie, Heritiers Loron, France 12.5% **27.00**

A good example of its type. Nice ruby colour with aromas of ripe fruit. Good acidity and juicy fruit on the palate – cranberries and cherries with a touch of spice. A versatile wine.

2014 Rosso di Montalcino, La Magia, Italy 13.5% **28.00**

A richly flavoured and rounded wine. The nose is full of warm ripe cherry, blackberry, cedar wood and spice notes. The palate has generous plum and red fruits, more spice and savoury characters leading to fine tannins and an elegant finish.

2012 Rioja Crianza, Hacienda Valvares, Spain 14% **28.00**

It is a big, complex but balanced wine mixed aromas of red & black fruits. The palate is packed with juicy bramble jam characters with toasty, spicy, coffee and cacao flavours.

2013 Domaine des Tourelles, Vallee de La Bekka, Liban 13% **31.00**

Abundant cassis and ripe morello cherry fruit are a feature of the Domaine de Tourelles red which is complex and multi-layered with firm yet appealing tannins and some spice on the finish.

2016 Cotes du Rhone, La Galetiere, France 14% **32.00**

A truly classis Cotes du Rhone blend of Grenache and Syrah. Rich, heady aromas of dark fruit capture the senses and evolve on the palate. An absolute treat.

2012 Stairway to Heaven, Cabernet Sauvignon, Spain 15.5% **32.00**

A complex Cabernet Sauvignon with fine spices and elegant fruit notes, which presents itself densely on the palate with powerful tannins.

2014 Zinfandel, Cline, California 14% **32.00**

Smooth complexity of supple tannins that mingle with flavours of dark berry, black cherry, strawberry, spice notes and vanilla with a lasting finish.

2014 Chianti Riserva 1489, Baroncini, Italy 13% **32.00**

Deep ruby red in colour with aromas of violets, wild cherries and subtle spice notes. On the palate the wine is full bodied and balanced with soft wild berry character and a hint of vanilla and cinnamon, coupled with a long finish.

- 2014 Yalumba Barossa, Old Bush Vine Grenache, Australia 13%** **33.00**
This wine is Barossa Grenache at its best. Bright red fruits and spice flow on to rich, yet savoury palate delivering a wine of elegance, tight structure and tremendous length.
- 2011 Classic Bordeaux, Lussac – St – Emilion, Ginestet, France 12.5%** **34.00**
Blend of Merlot 60%, Cabernet Franc 35% and Cabernet Sauvignon 5%. The Nose is rich in plum with spice and every mouthful is brimming with soft, sweet cherry fruit.
- 2015, Crossings, Pinot Noir, Marlborough, New Zealand 13.5%** **36.00**
Bramble fruit, cherry, spice and a hint of smoke on the nose: black cherry and plum on the palate supported by oak spice, soft tannins and a bright, refreshing finish
- 2015 Malbec, Terrazas de los Andes, Argentina 14.5%** **36.00**
Extremely fruity. Black cherries, prunes and raisins are combined with vanilla, caramel and toasted notes to define a very complex nose. Hints of violets stand out, typical of Malbec. Palate: great body, structure and volume; powerful wine. Despite its concentration its round and ripe tannins provide a soft and young character that anticipate great ageing potential.
- 2010 Oakridge Shiraz, Yarra Valley, Australia 13.2%** **37.00**
During the wines elevate, the wine was raked twice from its less in spring and then again early summer before blending in June after the following vintage. Red plum, cranberry, beetroot and white pepper aromas are followed on the palate with mint. Medium – bodied with fine savoury tannins.
- 2015 Tannat, Bodega Garzon, Uruguay 14.5%** **38.00**
This expression of Tannat is an intense red and black fruit wine with lingering aftertaste, freshness and softness. This wine is fermented in both new oak cask and sealed vats in order to soften out the tannins and to retain the characteristic black fruit flavour found in the Tannat grape.
- 2015 Appasimento Puglia IGT, Italy 14.5%** **38.00**
100% Tempranillo, Garnet cherry-red intense with aromas of blackberries and red currant. In the mouth, an excellent balance between fruit and wood provides creamy sensations and pleasant toasty notes.
- 2013 The Cover Drive, Cabernet Sauvignon, Jim Barry, Australia 14%** **39.00**
The nose is very fragrant, dominated by intense cassis and cedar, with nuances of fennel and damson. A generous palate with succulent tannins framing blackcurrant, liquorice and cherry flavour.
- 2014 Malbec, Bodega Primogenito, Patagonia Argentina 14.5%** **41.00**
Extremely popular, Argentinian Malbec is an inky, medium – bodied, dry red wine with strong impressions of dark fruits on the nose and palate. This wine tends to have mellower tannins than its French counterpart.
- 2013 Gigondas, Domaine La Haute Marone, France 14.5%** **42.00**
Intense aromas of ripe raspberries and black cherries, then a wisp of smoke creeps in along with some hints of grilled cocoa beans. Before the wine hits the palate, you know that you are in for an explosion of flavours!

- 2013 Chateauneuf-Du-Pape, Les Galets Roules, France 13.5%** **58.00**
This vintage is unoaked and displays the classic warm, spicy red fruit and damson aromas on the nose mingled with dense dark cherry flavours on the palate; the result is an attractively fresh and early-drinking vintage.
- 2013 Amarone Della Valpolicella, La Colombaia, Italy 15.5%** **58.00**
Full and intense red garnet colour, nose reminiscent of peaches and raisins. Lingering taste of mature cherry and liquorice enriched by a velvety body, vanilla flavours and red fruit jam aftertaste.
- 2001 Rioja Faustino I, Gran Reserva, Spain 13.5%** **59.00**
Blend of Tempranillo, Graciano, Mazuelo. The nose is very complex with red berries, cinnamon, clove and oak notes. The palate has a beautiful balance of tannin and acidity with lingering notes of berry fruit and spice on the finish.
- 2011 Robert Mondavi, Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California 14%** **62.00**
Fruit characteristics, such as blackberry and cassis, combined with spicy oak elements, lead to an elegant structure, with velvety tannins and excellent length. A Nappa Valley classic.
- 2013 Beaune Teurons, Premier Cru, Domaine Chanson, France 12.5%** **89.00**
Well – balanced, generous and silky. Smooth tannins and delicate oak note. Long finish.
- 2011 Gevery – Chambertin Louise Jadot, France 13%** **98.00**
A classic Burgundian Pinot Noir from some of the best premier cru vineyards in Beaune. It's a blend of grapes from five premier cru vineyards showing floral aroma with hints of roses and dark cherries.
